It is a burden for preachers to preach several times a week but also it is not easy to write a pastoral letter each week. Last week, one of the deacon has told me, "I have been reading your pastoral letter and it has been blessing. You are doing a good job." It has been a couple of years since I started writing but it was a first time hearing comments like that. A couple of months ago, Emeritus pastor said he read about the situation of Korea from my letter and it was good. It has encouraged me.

The pastoral letter is to share things like ministries, situations, meaningful Christian life and related stories that I am not able to share during my message or announcement times. Some people write it in a form of a short stories but I think I still have more to share.

Today, I would like to talk about Wednesday service. As I have been visiting Korean in the last few years, I see the changes in the society but also changes in churches. Sunday evening services have been disappearing and 2-3PM service for leaders and deacons and late afternoon services are the new added services on Sundays.

Wednesday serving moving to Friday service is pretty frequent change among churches. For young generations who work during the week, they move the service to Friday and moving the Sunday evening to Sunday afternoon. Health churches have changed the times of the services but the number of attendance did not decrease. Of course, what is more important than the numbers is the quality of the service.

As you have loved someone before, the quality of love equals the quantity of time spent. It is not enough to just attend Sunday service to fill our spiritual needs. We are considering moving Wed service to Friday (It will after much prayers and discussion) What is more important is that coming to Sunday and Wednesday service to be beneficial for our spiritual walk.

Today's new generation needs to go all in for the worship. As the demands of life and quality of life have increased, people turned away from worship. It is the responsibilities of parents to send children to Awana on Wednesdays. Even if you do not send kids to Awana, praising and worshipping God one more day in a week and praying and listening to the words of God is pleasing to Him.

How can our faith grow if we do not spend time in worship? I encourage all of you to come to Wednesday service and be blessed. God is looking for the one who worship Him. Who can boast about how well he/she is worshipping God enough for the grace of the cross? This is the time we act on our decision to worship God.

I love you and thank you. I bless you in the name of the Lord.
