That is when we started the small church support offering (Local Church support) Many of TFBC members supported so we were able to help both Pastors' wives. Now, Mrs Myung Choi has become a pastor and continue the ministry. We have been supporting the local church youth retreat that Pastor Moses Choi started.

What was in my heart always was the family of Late Pastor Sungtak Lim. When he passed away, his wife was in surgery for her heart. Their own child, Eunsung was born prematurely and he has cerebral palsy and developmental disability.

As I was coming back to US last week, I heard the shocking news. Now Mrs. Lim also went to be with the Lord. As I heard the news, I thought of Eunsung. He is not well and now he has to live without both of his parents. Who would comfort him and the rest of the family!

Last Monday, I went to the funeral with my wife to do the benediction but I was just speechless. It was most difficult benediction that I have done in my life. I was thinking of what to say as I drove to Lynnwood.

Believers were different. The families of the deceased were persevere pain and suffering as they worshipped God during the service. It brought respect in my heart.

Everyone! If there is no God, no Jesus, and no resurrection, how meaningfulness our lives might be? If we are not given the written word of God, where will we receive the comfort? If we do not have the church community in Christ, how lonely we might become?

We do not have enough time to love one another. We do not have enough time to share the hope of the resurrection. Isn't it so?
