To Loving members of TFBC after 35th KSBC Annual meeting,

This past week, the first time in Northwest and first time in the 40 years of TFBC, TFBC hosted the biggest Korean denomination event with a great joy. We can guess how big the event was by knowing that We had 700 pastors and their families gathered for each night service.

Above all, we praise God for allowing us to take this opportunity to successfully hold the event. Every morning, we prayed for KSBC with Nehemiah chapter 8. Pastors and their wives who gathered for the annual meeting were like the Israelites who gathered after finishing the walls as we hosted the event after the drainage pipe and building remodeling.

As priests and Levis' led the praise and worship after rebuilding the wall, TFBC praise team's praises went up to God and the singing of TFBC choir was great enough to be even on TV as the guest speaker had complimented.

There were two places that were like a battle field. One was the media room and the other was the kitchen. From the morning to 11PM, without a break, media team went with so many different request from different people and finished the job.

The kitchen was like reliving the Israelites of rebuilding the wall in 52 days. 50 kitchen team and serving team members were like a special force team. One of the pastor said, "I guess even ladies in Tacoma seemed like they were trained like the military." Many complimented the great food and the great taste of kimch and also shared that no church has prepared 3 dinners for the KSBC.

As I saw many shedding sweats and tears for serving, my heart led to pray for the kitchen team. The prayers lifted for them were louder than the ones in the sanctuary.

MMU who set up, cooked meat and supported parking lot, the team who served for the mission cafe, young adults who helped with the setting up on the Sunday afternoon, Pastors, Ordained Deacons and church staff who had few hours of sleep each night to serve, EM who supported Parking lot and many other hard labors, child care team, youth and young adults who supported the prep and led youth worship, the intercessory prayer team who prayed every day at 8PM, and all the names that I can not even list all are all listed in the book of Life just like the word of Nehemiah.

Before we completed our 40th anniversary year, we have accomplished what God was pleased with. We have served the pastors and servants who have been tired from the ministries, God tells us this, "Good and faithful servant, thank you and job well done. As you have served the servants with joy, there will be a crown of life and heavenly blessings upon all of you."

Saturday morning, one deacon asked me, "Did we do a good job?" I said, "Yes, of course." All of us had done well. One pastor sent me a message yesterday that as he has been attending KSBC for 30 years since his youth days with his father, this was by far the most beautiful KSBC meeting with full of grace and serving heart.

God has done it through us. Hallelujah!
