" you have little strength, yet..."

This era has entered into the battle of the energy. While I was in Korea, due to the historical heat, we left ac on for the whole day and it caused the ac to malfunction. With the issues with lack of power in the hot summer, it led to people only being able to turn on ac on certain times for different regions.

Many enjoy the brighter lights in the main sanctuary. It is true that our sanctuary was a little dim. As we went through the parking lot and drainage pipe construction, we added lights in the parking lot. These lights are LED lights. Many new houses now uses LED and its advantage is saving energy. For example, LED lights we have in the sanctuary and the parking lot is 5-10 times brighter but uses only 1/7 or 1/10 of what we used to use. Many cities encourage all public places and companies to change to LED and even offers incentives.

It is the same for our screens in the sanctuary. What we used to have was a projector that magnify the visual and shoot it to the screen. Its life span is about 3 years. It was estimated to cost us 38,000 for the replace of the projector and the screen. For LED screens we have, they cost 54,000. it functions as the projector and the screen. They are more expensive than the projector but there is a couple of big important differences in the functions. HD projector has a life span of 20,000 hours but LED screen has 50,000 which is almost 3 times the life span of the projector. For the energy efficiency perspective, LED screens also conserves energy.

As we see these LED which provides more lights but conserve more energy, it reminded me of the two important words. One is "faithful and the other is "effective" For Christians in terms of God's mission, there should be faithfulness that does not change and efficiency that the talents are used as wise Steward of God. Christian's faithfulness to God must continue for a long time till Jesus returns and also the blessing that we have received. Even if we have received a little talents, we must efficiently use them without complains.

There are mentions of 7 churches in the book of Revelation. Out of 7, 6 were scolded by Jesus. There is only one church that was commended. It is the church of Philadelphia. The bible tells of the reason in Revelation 3:8. "I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name."

It is so. The church of Philadelphia had the least amount of talents amount the 7 churches but they were faithful and with the small strengthen they served the Lord.  
Now, we live in the world that is in need of the faithfulness which we continue to shine the light and efficiency which is efficiently shine the lights in every corner of the world.
