Almost 400 people lost their lives and many of them were Christians who were in Easter Service. Some were children just ours who were also baptized. Many Christians in Sri Lank are in despair.

Let us pray for them. Let us find things we can do for them.

We are all indebted for the Love of Christ. We are indebted for the martyrs of early period Christian pioneers and we are indebted for our fellow Christians who are being persecuted. Let us pray that God's power of resurrection and hope will cover their wounds and restore them as they are in sadness and in fear. Let us also pray that the blood of martyrs are not wasted but by their sacrifices, on the day of Pentecost, great work of Holy Spirit will be done.

We all are indebted to the love of Christ. If we remember just this one truth, we can rise up from any hardship and be joyful and be blessed.
