Hallelujah! I praise the name of our Lord. Today is the day we give thanks to God for watching over us for the first half of the year as we celebrate the feast of harvest. Let this season be the time we remember what God has done for us.

I have finished the preaching ministry in the Korean Ministry thanks to your prayers. I preached for Air Force headquarter in Osan and I met with missionaries from China to help them with hospital check up and connected them to Korean churches for them to preach in.

From July, with Malaysia Mission Team, Summer missions start. 14 member team will go to Malaysia from July 8 to 19. We will pray for them during EM service and 3rd KM service today and on July 8, we will pray for them during the 8AM service and they will depart to Malaysia. They will be ministering in two cities, Kuala Lumpur and Penang, Malaysia. Kuala Lumpur is the city that MJ Kwon whom we sent and support is doing mission work and Penang is the city that Missionary Ko that we support ministers.

In Kuala Lumpur, the team will be doing VBS in the refugee school. Most of the students are Myanmar Refugees and 30 of them will be attending VBS. In the morning, worship, praise, Bible Study(English Class), Craft and game will be parts of VBS and in the afternoon, the team will visit homes and prepare for the next day. The team will also visit Muslim Mosque. For a day, the team will visit the church that our children ministry dept has sent shoes and gifts.

In Penang, the team will lead evangelism event to Chinese Malaysian youth and Young adults on two nights. 25% of Malaysian population is Chinese Malaysian and they control the economics. They are conservative and many of them are Buddhist.

The events will consist of praise, body worship, special songs, skits, testimony and message in an hour and half and also using ice breakers to minister to the nonbelievers. Each night, there will be altar calls to invite people to accept Jesus as their lord and savior. On Sunday, the team will visit a local church and perform a special song and in the afternoon, the team will meet with the local church youth and young adults to have fellowship.

Malaysia is Muslim country and it is illegal to share gospel to Malays. Through the refugee school and evangelism event, the team will go to city to city to share gospel messages and praise God. They are in need of your prayers since many part of the country is spiritually dark.

In the last 3 months, the team has been meeting every Saturday morning for 3 years of training, prayers and devotion to prepare for the mission. Through various fundraisers, they raise funds for the mission. With your supports and prayers, they will leave to mission next week. 3 adults, 4 young adults and 7 youth will be in the team. (Pastor Jake Ahn, Eunhyang Kim, Gary Chang, Angela Kwak, Leah An, David Walker, David Glessman, Alyssa Loun-Lowery, Yuna Kim, Grace Min, Sky Kim, Nathanael Kirkwood, Kyeongseo Min, Lois Yoo)

The prayer request from the team is to see even one soul receiving Christ. You are also doing mission with the team as you send them off and pray for them through your intercessory prayers. Please remember to pray for them that God will guide them and protect them and they will return safely. Pray for all 14 members as well as the missionaries in Malaysia.
