It is a good memory now but I remember everyone celebrating together and eating and sharing together even if you are poor. It was like a Passover meal in Old Testament. All these took places for my family centering around my church.

Many of our church members are immigrants and we miss Korea but often forgetting some of the traditional Korean holidays. For us, we have Thanksgiving Day, Christmas and Resurrection Sunday which are Christian and American holidays and we celebrate those holidays. So it seems like many of Korean Americans are losing the traditions of Korean holidays.

We had yutnori game with villages around this time last year and it was a shock to me. I always saw everyone serving together and worshipping God but once the games started, everyone was so eager to win and I just saw different sides of members being very competitive. ^^ I was thinking maybe some are blinded by the prizes that old selves are coming out. I was laughing and enjoying the actions. I am trying to say that it was a good thing.

Pastors are most happy when members are happy. It was just great seeing church congregation laughing and enjoying fellowship together. It was good in the eyes of a pastor so it must have been even greater in the eyes of our God.


Last December, we relieved our stresses of the whole year by seeing everyone showing their talents through the Jesus Village Festival with so much laughter. When you are happy, I am happy. When we are happy, God is pleased.

Next Sunday at 2PM, we will have another Yutnori game with the whole church at the gym. Even if you do not belong to a village, you will be assigned to a team when you come. As you participate these events, you realized that you are the church. As you get to know one another and have fellowship, our church becomes one. If you only come to services, you will not grow much.

Yutnori is a Korean traditional game but I encourage all EM to participate and cheer for your wives and families. Also youth and YAM should come and participate. The game itself is not a purpose but to get to know and have fellowship is the purpose. Even if our languages and cultures are different, families should meet more often and talk. Bible tells us that we are built up in Christ together. That is the church. We all are a part of a church.
