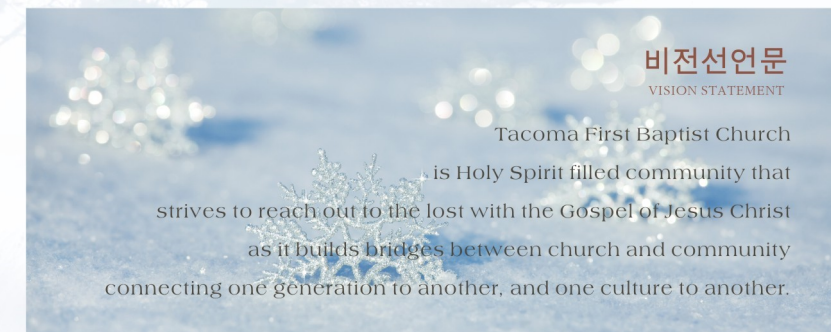

The world is very troublous today. It is not just small incidents but huge incidents take place that shocks us. The storm that might come once in a thousand year came and damaged Houston and then anther mega hurricane came through Puerto Rico to Florida. One week after the storm, 1.6 million people in Puerto Rico still were without power and only 5% had power. Some of the scientists are worried that due to two earthquakes in Mexico and one in Peru and now one in Japan might affect the Pan Asia and possibly cause "The Big One" to come to the area.

North Korea is not stopping from developing nuclear weapon and missiles and continues to be come a threat to Asia. In Europe, minor and major terrorist attacks from ISIS and putting people in fear.

Shooting incidents continues in US. As a matter of fact, last year, one of the student from Rogers High school was showing his gun to his visiting friends and pulled the trigger by accident and causing his friend to die instantly. The person in question had enough wealth and he was normal when he was in school. People who were neighbors to him said that he was not those kinds of person who would commit such a crime.

This is the issue of spirit. A man is innately sinner and lives in the bondage of sin by the evil. Bible shows that nature is facing damages from the fall of men. Believing in God means through he blood of Jesus, the soul relive and being reconcile to God and continue the relationship with God. Then the new value and thoughts must take place in us. Our perspective of seeing the things and the happening must be biblical world view.

Then as we see the world of many things going on, what do we need to do? We must come to the place of prayers. As I have shared last Sunday, if you do not pray, that means there is no spirit of Christ in you or the love in your heart has grown cold.

This is the time for us to pray more than ever. At home, at early morning service, at intercessory prayer room, and work places, instead of complaining about the world of chaos, we must respond through prayers by listening to the Holy Spirit. As I have shared last week, with "Spirit of Thanksgiving, Spirit of Love, Spirit of repentance and Spirit of Discernment" we must pray for our families, neighbors and people to God who is sovereign.

Especially this Wednesday, let us come together as a church to pray for Korea Peninsula at 7PM. EM should also come and pray for their wives' country and neighbor country. As we face our limits, we should pray more. As we kneel down before God, the darkness will kneel before God as well.

"if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:14)
