To the loving TFBC members before my visit to Korea,
I will be visiting Korea tomorrow on for my vacation. I will miss three Sundays and Pastor Moon, Pastor Min, Pastor Yoo and Pastor Frank will be preaching on Sundays. The purpose of the visit has two folds. The first is for the health check up and to rest. My wife has to get her brain tumor checked up every 2 years. This time we were referred from the doctor who came to speak at our KM revival, Dr. Chung. I will also go through medical check ups and get treated for the issues I found two years ago.

The second fold is to visit churches and possibly preach in some of the churches. I will be visiting churches that I can learn from in terms of their strength and focus ministries. The church known for their devotionals, the church known for cell group ministry, the church known for their early bird services, the church known for their school system, I will be visiting those churches. Please pray for me that there will be opportunities for me to learn and also be refreshed. I am not sure if I will be able to but I am planning to visit our brother church in China for their August 8th church building dedication service. (Considering the situation in China, we need to keep this confidential)

During Last deacons' meeting, leaders selected and formed a bylaw committee with 13 members. Also we formed an advisory board with leaders who have served in TFBC for 30 years. They are advisory board members who understand TFBC tradition and cultures and they will be helpful whenever the bylaw committee has any questions.

Soon, summer ministries will continue with Korean Summer School. It starts on August 1 and they are in need of 12-15 teachers and volunteers. In the afternoons, they will run English and Math classes. I hope that many of you will support and help. As you know, pastors will be preaching for the services before each day starts for Korean School. Whatever we do, our purpose is to proclaim the gospel.

There will be people going on summer vacations, summer missions, and retreats. Jesus Village Community will also have picnic within each community. Wherever you are, I encourage you to continue to support and pray for TFBC community.

A Retreat means retrieve in military. Churches use the word, retreat. The summer ministries and vacations have the similar meanings. What we were not able to do in terms of spiritual trainings during the regular season, we do in the summer but also rest as well.

I pray that all the ministries and rest in the summer will be a refreshing time for the next stages in the season and be ready to bear fruits in the fall. I hope all of you will be well and I will see you soon.
