As I prepared each morning message like I prepare Sunday message and I preach full-throated message and cried out to heaven with a desperate heart. As I meditated Jesus' prayer in Gethsemane as His sweats dropped like a blood drop, I hung on to those words.

In fact, what did Korean churches have to experience the revival in the past? Korea churches were establish with prayer movement with repentance and words of God. The reason for Korean church and Western churches weakening is because they lost the wild nature of prayer. As technologies developed, people start to have visible things that they can depend on so no longer they cry out to heaven. As knowledge increase, they depended more on reasoning than the wisdom from God.

So, maybe that is why God is throwing different kinds of hardship so that He can bring back His people. One great hope that we have at TFBC is praying members, praying parents, praying children, praying church. Not only at the early morning prayers, but through Wed service, and all worship services, we are awake and pray-ing.

When the reformation started in Britain, Queen Mary order to persecute and kill Christians. She was known as Bloody Mary. However, the key person in this refor-mation, John Knox cried out to God in tear every day. Maybe it was a coincidence or not but the Queen Mary got sick and died and the persecution to Christians stopped. Queen Mary left these last words and she confessed that this was not a coincidence. "I am more scare of one praying John Knox than one million army)

The meaning of Resurrection Sunday comes more valuable as we cry out at the foot of the Cross. On Resurrection Sunday, I pray in the name of our lord that God's amazing joy will be upon all of you who are parts of the church community.
