Please pray that the mission team will be able to minister to them through VBS and haircut ministry.

Another ministry is the World Changers that youth have been going each year and they are going in July. Southern Baptist churches come together to help and support local churches and community in the area. Please pray that they will be challenged spiritually and physically just like the foreign missions.

Another ministry in the summer is the Summer Korean School. Through the Korean School, many were evangelized and many English speaking people got to learn Korean culture and the language. Please pray for the Korean school and the volunteers and join in promoting the Korean school.

On the second Sunday of August, there is church-wide Olympic. It will be at Spanaway Park and we will enjoy the beautiful Washington weather and join in for fellowship to unite as one. It would be also we can wear the church t-shirts together for the event.

And there are different retreats and meetings for communities and departments. I pray that through these ministries in summer, we will have one heart and be spiritually refreshed to be ready for ministries starting in the fall. God leads the mission and ministries of church and it is completed through the obedience of God's children. When your serving hands are there, God is glorified and pleased. God works through us.
