

To Loving Members of TFBC,

I am writing this at a conference place, 2 hours away from Frankfurt. This is the same place that I came 2 years ago to share messages to Korean European International Students. We are about to close the conference with a last service.

I was here 2 years ago and shared 4 messages but I remember that conference as my worst preaching's at the KOSTA in Europe. So I really wanted to do a better job of serving this time.
At KOSTA, not only you share messages but also do individual counseling with students who request a counseling with guest speakers. It seems like I got more popular this time that more than 10 students/participants requested for counseling session with me so it was a busy conference without much rest time.

There were many different counseling topics relating to future after school, relationship issue, depression, suicidal thoughts, divorce, finance. One male student said he knew me from 2 years ago at KOSTA. I was grateful that he remembered me despite my poor preaching back then. 2 years ago, I preached on trials and comfort of life and the last day, I preached on Holiness and Homosexuality. After a short pause, he hesitated and then he shared about his life as homosexuality. My heart was heavy. I was not sure how I would go about this. He said he remembered my message 2 years ago. And then he realized that homosexuality was a sin that He has been committing for the last 10 years and he must repent before God. From that moment, he started the healing process and he confessed he is now almost fully recovered from the sin.

After hearing my message on Wednesday, he decided to have a counseling session with me and share his testimony. He did not know back then how he could contact me and did not know that I would return to Europe KOSTA to preach again. Since he was able to see me again, he is confessing his past life that he could not share with anyone else.

My heart was filled with joy. I had this great hope. With TFBC members support and prayers, I came a long way to Europe to preach and thinking I did a poor job preaching. However, my message changed a brother's life who lived as a homosexual from his childhood.

Word of God seems like a mustard seed but after being planted, it bears amazing fruits. With being jet lagged, I was going to do my counseling till Wednesday but with hearing this brother's testimony that energized my heart, I continue my sessions after Wednesday.

The highlight of KOSTA was the Thursday Night. I felt God's presence more than any other services. I saw God's word and worship time to God was leading students and young adults who were influenced by European culture and anti-Christianity culture to the repentance and true freedom. I am writing this on Friday and I hear many testimonies continuing with people.

Sometimes we forget why we plant a seed of gospel to the lost. Sometimes we don't because we are lazy. Sometimes it is because we are worried how people will react to the gospel. However, the word of God has the power and when we obey God's command and proclaim the gospel, the lost will return and be healed from fatal disease and be forgiven for the sins of their lives. Let us bring people to Love Tacoma in March so that people can hear the message of healing and power during the KM Revival.

I love you and thank you. I bless you in the Lord.
