To Loving members of TFBC after 2016 VBS,

This year's VBS had the most number of children attendance for the last 6 years. In 2011, 120 students had participated. This year, the number of children alone were 200 and volunteers and staff totaled about 150. The half of the children attending the VBS were from the local area and our community family members.

For Parents who are not members of TFBC to trust their children with us for 5 days meant that the children really enjoyed our VBS. It is not exaggeration to say that TFBC VBS is known as a good program for the local community for several years.

New Children Pastor, Nathan Namkung and his wife led the VBS team with the great leadership and all pastors supported VBS. People worked from the parking lot to running errands and especially kitchen team had led another great work for 5 days. One of the kids attending VBS told me that he was looking forward to the wed lunch because TFBC spaghetti is one of the best in the area.

What was more noticeable was the involvements of the youth and college/ young adults. They grew up attending VBS so they understood the hearts of the children. They were not just leading praise and games but many youth and college students served the children. Their efforts of preparing for many nights to teach children produced many great fruits especially through the Thursday altar call.

During the altar call, many of the children came up on the stage for their responses of faith and I saw many of the youth and teachers praying for the children with tears. The prayers continued for 30 minutes. Some of the children' continuing the prayers even back at their seats were witnessed.

This was like a small celebration from Heaven. God was glorified through VBS. Great work every one.

Today, we will be forming by-law committee during the deacons' meeting. Church leadership has been building a barebones structure of the bylaw with considering cultures and biblical values of TFBC with great efforts. Now. going with 3 steps of processes, TFBC will go through making of Bylaw for the next 6 months.

First, once the bylaw committee is formed, they will go through 3 months of studying and working on the bylaw. Second, once the work is done by the committee, deacon body will review it through 3 meetings in Oct and Nov. Third, in December, with two business meeting with congregations which is the SBC tradition, the bylaw will be affirmed by the church.

TFBC Constitution and bylaw will emphasize on confessing our faith and making a covenant before God, setting the order of the church and building the church as gospel community.

As all are complete, with the new bylaw next year, continue to pray that TFBC will focus on preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ just what we have done through VBS.
