#### To Beloved members of TFBC

According to several statistics, 90% of current church attendees have experienced Christianity or accepted Jesus before the age of 19. Early Christian education is that important to change someone's life. Another alarming stat is 60-70% of students stop going to churches after their high school years.

With these two contrasting stats, we can learn three things. The first is that how important it is for parents to lead their children to their churches when their children are still under the spiritual care of the parents.

The second is our efforts and concerns of how we can prepare students as they graduate from high schools and enter into colleges and the world that are filled with free ideologies.

The third is that through these two things, how can families and the church work together to prepare the children to live as great soldiers of Christ as they leave the nest of home and enter into the world.

In that sense, VBS is a powerful program that can equip children to be the people of God in a short amount of time. During the VBS, the impact that they receive from the spiritual community is great. Worship, Bible study, worship dance, praises and other activities allow them to worship God and to have fellowship with each other so that they can experience their lives change greatly.

And this is the first time in their lives where many children accept Jesus as their savior and lord in public. You experience the power of God's presences as you see over 100 children coming up to the stage and kneeling down to pray during the VBS altar call. And seeing those who had been there at the stage, grow up to be the teachers and volunteers and praying for children makes us realize what a church is about.

VBS that is our greatest evangelism event is only 3 weeks away. In order for us to serve 300 children who will be participating, we need 200 volunteers including kitchen staff and parking lot volunteers. What we are thankful for is that many youth and young adults who grew up through the VBS are now serving as teachers and volunteers and serving the VBS. I also want to show my gratitude to those who serve for VBS in the kitchen every VBS, and those who take their own vacation time to serve in VBS.

This year again, there will be an altar call where over 100 children will come up to the stage to kneel down to pray. This is the moment that God is pleased with and waits for as He built this church. For this moment, we serve with our own sweats and efforts.

As there has not been any big incident during VBS in the past, let us pray for God's grace and protection to overflow upon all children, volunteers and staff. Now summer ministries begins with VBS so I ask you to pray for all retreats, and summer mission trips and pray for the safety and Holy Spirit's working in everyone's lives.

A great church is not built up without efforts. When the efforts continues for the next generations, the great work of God continues. God builds up His church through faithful ones.
