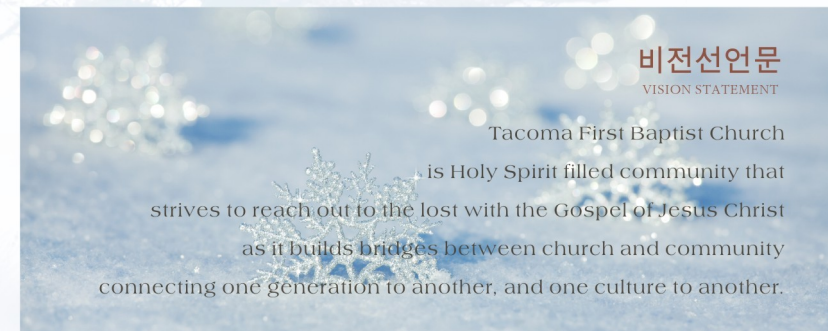

This year marks the 500th anniversary of reformation by Martin Luther. Oct 31, 1517, Martin Luther who was Catholic priest and Seminary professor wanted to reform the theology of Roman Catholic by posting 95 thesis on the door of Wittenberg Chapel which lead to the reformation.

Back then, the Bible was not accessible by laity due to the languages therefore people can only depend on the authority of Roman Catholic and Roman Catholic had abused this power to take labor, materials and human rights.

So the motto of reformation by Martin Luther was, Sola Scriptura-Only by Scripture, Sola Gratia-only by Grace, and Sola Fide-Only by Faith. The begging of the reformation was to bring back the word of God to all members. To fulfill the priesthood of believers, knowing the Bible was priority.

TFBC focuses on teaching the Bible through Wednesday Services as well as Sunday Bible Study and Discipleship trainings for KM and EM.

Many members have simple knowledge about Bible but many also lack in overall understanding of Bible and also topical knowledge.

Christians must love the word of God and be able to feed themselves with the word of God. We must know the word and live according to the word so that we can bridge the world to God just as Jesus did.
