Dr. Luis Bush of Argentine is worldly known Mission Stagiest. He introduced 10/40 window in 1990s and brought turning point for the world mission. 2/3 of world population lives in 10/40 window and Among 3 Billion people which is 97% of the population in 10/40 are non-believers and those areas are Southeast Asia which includes, China and India and North Africa.

In July 23-25, 300 Korean mission leaders are meeting in Wheaton College in Chicago. I will be translating for Dr. Bush during the conference and also speak for the conference. It is an important conference which faces 30th anniversary in Wheaton College.

However, After talking about 10/40, he recently shared something more important which is 4/14 window. According to reliable search, 90% of the believers accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior by the age of 19 or younger.

Dr. Louis Bush said from age 4 to 14 is an important time for them to accept Jesus and 80% of believers accepted Jesus during that time. During this time period of their life, their Christian values and world views are formed and after the age 14, they continue with their lives with the values and world views that have been already developed. Charles Spurgeon who is known as the prince of preaching said the faith of children is greater than adults because Christian education during children age determine the whole life.

I was challenged and blessed when I went to Korean military revival last year where 15,000 soldiers got together. The place where young soldiers who met Jesus in the military or their childhood or youth years, were filled with passion and it is the place where they can listen to the gospel and go out to the world.

From June 26, VBS which has age 4 to 14 according to Dr. Bush starts. This is the most important and biggest evangelistic ministry at TFBC. Even if we have more adults come to church, if we fail in this ministry, there is no future for the church. However, TFBC grew through VBS ministry each year. Also we were able to get closer to the neighborhood and multiethnic groups through VBS.

We have about 200 registrations for VBS. I hope 100 spots will be filled with local neighborhood children. We need more volunteers and teachers. All youth and young adults enjoy and wait for this time. They grew up being blessed through VBS in the last 7 years. Some of the volunteers took vacation days to serve. As a senior pastor, I thank them and have respect for them.

As a matter of fact, TFBC VBS has the longest program each day in Washington but also longest in the duration of VBS. 5 days are enough time to open the hearts of the children at VBS. Despite the length of VBS, some children ask why we don't have winter VBS. This shows how exciting and blessing for the children. We need prayer supports for safety. Please pray for children and volunteers in the morning, in the intercessory prayer room, homes, and at work.
