Luciano Pavarotti, Placido Domingo and Jose José Carreras were known as top 3 tenors of our time. They were often on stage together but Carreras from Barcelona, Spain did not like Domingo from Madrid of Spain. They fought over a minor issue and they separated their ways. In 1983, Carreras he found to be suffering from acute lymphoblastic leukemia and treatments he had over the years pushed him to the financial difficulties.

One day, Carreras found out about charitable research organization that treats leukemia. After being treated one day, he asked how the organization was established. He was speechless after hearing that the trustee was Domingo. Domingo started this research center to treat his friend Carreras.

In 1987, all three of them were on stage together. Carreras kneeled before the crowd and said to Domingo, "I am sorry. Forgive me." Domingo responded without hesitation, "It is important to save a person's life. It is not right that someone with talents like that to be wasted." These two friends overcame their differences and became a respectful friends and continue to touch the hearts of the people all around the world with their singing.

As you do ministries at church, you misunderstand each other, fight with each other and be angry at each other. As a church is a holy place, as I enter in, the community become imperfect. The church is between perfect and imperfect. I am between perfect and imperfect. As we accept Jesus as our love and savior, looking to Christ, we are moving from imperfect to perfect.
