Last week, we had nice warm weather which is rare for March. I hear there are flowers blossoming in UW. Many of our church members are walking around the church and enjoying the fragrance of Spring. Daycare children were enjoying the outside playground and many senior adults came out to the Senior community meeting.

As I am writing this, Youth and YAM are busy preparing for Love Tacoma for the past weekend. As I see this beautiful sites, I also think God given good weather did something as well. Now, I think it will start to rain. Washington should have rain in the winter and spring so that it is prepared for dry summer.

I think it is the same for spiritual aspect. We just want Spring and Fall but there should be summer and winter so that we can truly enjoy other seasons. When there is no trails in our spiritual walk, we forget God's grace and become prideful. Trials and suffering allows us to remember that even just living a life is God's grace.

As I have shared with you during leadership meeting, last year we had the highest offering in the years I have served here. As you might have seen in the bulletin, our first week of 2019 offering was the highest in any given week in the history of TFBC.

Actually, before I came to TFBC, TFBC faced difficulties with trusting finances. Even after I came to TFBC, because of an issue, there were people who did not do offering for many years. Currently March finance is twice the amount, excluding designated offerings in 9 years.

Our churches do not have any property loan payment going out for the 10 acre land and buildings and also 10 acre prayer mountain because of the devotion of the first generations. However, we had to spend a good amount of money for the drainage construction, parking lot construction and fixing and remodeling Antioch and Gym in the last 8 years. With gym floor construction in 2011, we spent 2 million dollars so far but with this difficult task, we were able to finish well with your devotion and support. This means you have given more to church outside your tithing.

This does not mean we decrease our mission support and local support. We expanded our support from China and Philippines to Africa, Europe, and Islam areas and we also had 2 mission conferences, first time in Washington we had Korean SBC annual meeting, and through M52 and Yi scholarship, we were able to support many small local churches and hundreds of pastors, missionaries and their families and also people in and out of church as well.

When your finance was not great, you gave through tithing, and other offering and when it comes down to missions and supporting others, you gave the support when I asked and as a senior pastor, I give you my thanks from bottom of my heart. I also want to thank Nehemiah Team, office staff, finance team and counting team(always working behind the scene), steering committee, all deacons, all WMU and MMU, all volunteer teams, village leaders and pastors.

God is the owner of this church. Jesus is the head of this church. All of us, including me are the people of God and God's children. Now, I thank God for the blessing that God will give through Love Tacoma and I encourage you to come to Love Tacoma KM Revival so that we can expect God's pouring of new vision and blessing.
