Olympia is filled with color changed leaves and as you go north, we see different areas with changes in colors. For TFBC, we have Harvest Night, Thanksgiving Sunday and many other ministry that harvest the fruits.

This year, we have three different mission teams and out of two are to the Muslim countries. The last team that is about to be sent off is to Turkey where Missionary J and E are ministering.

Turkey is different from other Muslim countries. They do not consider Islam as their country religion since 1928 and they are known as most secularized Islam country. But in reality, out of 80 million population, 98% are Muslim and They are strong Islam country where they mediate conflict between Saudi Arabia and Iran. They are strong Islam country.

Also, they are the biggest recipient of Syrian refugee. They accepted 5 million people and EU is supporting Turkey of 3Billion Euro for accepting refugees.

There are 6,000 Christians in Turkey which is 0.007% of the population and there are 140 churches and 2,000 missionaries. The reason that it is important to evangelize Turkey is that geologically, they can be a tunnel to minister to 22 Middle East Countries and also it is the place where NT Early Churches were planted and we are praying that once again churches will rise up by the work of the spirit.

Acts 21 shows Paul was born in the region of Turkey and Asia region in the book of Acts are now considered Turkey.

The team will leave on Monday and fly over night to arrive in Germany at 8AM. We will then change the flight twice and arrive at 10PM. That night, we will send some of the luggage to the final destination and stay the night.

From the next day, we will visit 7 churches of in Asian Minor of NT and pray there. There is also Colossae church there. After being there for 2 days, we will do cross country to Vonn. That is where missionary J and E from TFBC are ministering to Kurds.

Kurdish people are the people group who live in Iran, Iraq, Syria borders and there are 30 million of them without a country. They are also Muslim but have conflicts with Turkish and often revolt. Missionary J is Turkish and ministry to the Kurdish people and planting a church. The team will stay with them and worship, evangelize and minister with the Kurdish people.

Pray for the safety and for Missionary J and E and their ministries. Also pray that Turkey that has many Christian holy land and Kurdish people who have been without a country for 4,000 years that they will be God's people. I am excited to be where 7 churches of Revelation are.
