To Loving Members of TFBC

Including today's service, 3 more Lord's Day services and 2017 will be gone forever. Now is the time we wrap up the year and be ready for the new year. In that sense, we should stop and think about the new year in the next two weeks.

As a community perspective, TFBC started the 42nd year in Nov. In those 42 years, we did 4 different major constructions and in the last 7 years we repaired and remolded aging buildings. In 2011, we put a new floor for the gym so children can play safely and the following year, we finished the main sanctuary lobby floor. And 2014, parking lot drainage pipe construction that was long overdue in 18 years was done along with two parking lot construction which was finished in the winter.

Beautiful Prayer Mountain repair and the purchase of the Sheridan street was done along with the playground construction for the children. Drainage pipe construction and the parking lot construction was the big portion but along with other constructions, we spent about 1.5 million in the last 7 years for different constructions. With your support and prayers, we now have only \$250,000 left as a loan. Thankfully, we do not have any debts besides the loan. I want to earnestly thank God's grace and everyone of your tearful sacrifice. I also want to thank Nehemiah Team and Pastors and Ordained Deacons.

Despite these constructions, we did not reduce any support for mission or finance and we were able to increase the number of mission field support and community support because God made it possible and we obeyed His will who is the Lord of the church.

With Haggai 1:8, we called this construction project as Planting Thousand Trees Campaign and shared with the members that we would pledge one tree (\$1,200) or more. In order for us to finish paying off \$250,000, we should all devote a little more. It is my hope to finish this project so that we can build facilities for the prayer mountain. Many are praying for the expansion of the prayer mountain.

Since we have many new comers in the last year, I wanted to share about the purpose of the campaign.

One more thing that I want to ask is the team commitment card that you have received in the bulletin. Many are already serving but if you want to serve in a different team or did not have an opportunity to serve before, it is the chance for you to pray and make a commitment as God leads you. It goes same for all who received the deacon appointment letter. We are in need of village leaders as many villages will multiply next year.

Tacoma First Baptist Church is where it si because of the sacrifice and serving of the members in the last 42 years. Jesus who is the head of the church commanded us for the workers of the harvest and is waiting for the workers. There is nothing more blessing than serving in the kingdom of God.
