## To Loving Members of TFBC

This year, the Lent started on Feb 14, Wed. The Lent comes from the meaning of revival of all things. It connects to the meaning of Jesus' death brings the all nation to life. We are also reminded of Jesus' fasting for 40 days in the desert after being baptized by John the Baptist.

Lent starts with Ash Wednesday or the day or repentance which has the tradition of putting a ash on the forehead and repent. It starts on Wednesday and continue for 40 days till March 29 which is 40 days excluding Sunday.
