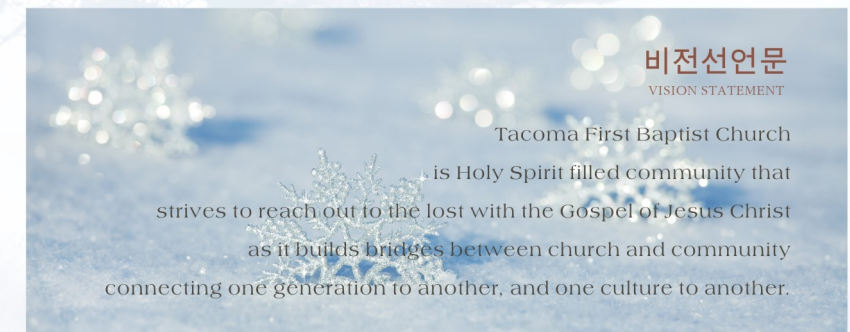

As the rain season started, the temperature has been dropped. The secular holiday, Halloween is coming soon and Thanksgiving and Christmas is around the corner. I read the last year's pastoral letter and I wanted you to read it again. (Of course, you might have forgotten all ^^)

As we face Halloween and the election

American culture critic, social historian, and professor of John’s Hopkins, Morris Berman wrote a book, called The Twilight of American Culture.

The book claimed that American is facing what Roman Empire of 4-5th century where they faced societal chaos. One example is the difference of riches and poor, growing number or illiteracy, rejecting of intellectuals. 16 years after the book was written, American is even in the worse place.

But many are not realizing this dark reality seriously. The reason is because of all the new technology, they do not see the reality. Berman said that the going back-ward of American society is its dynamics.

Another socialist, Robert Kaplan said, America covers itself as democratic country but when you examine the inside it is turning into oligarchy with a few of the companies controlling. A social critic Frank Thomas said in his book, Dark Age, the society became a result of product where it is controlled by the companies and their imagination.

The presidential election is just around the corner. American citizens are having a headache of who they need to vote out of two least attractive candidates in the history. Republican Party is no longer able to nominate conservative candidates. Christians cannot voice about who people should vote. This is a sign of how America is falling apart.

Berman shared very meaningful analysis at the end of his book: History is not made the way human wants. It is true. God is the ruler of the history. No matter how confusing the human history seems, it is God who creates and controls.

In a week, it is Halloween. In two weeks, it is presidential election. What we can do as Christian is pray for the new leader, discern so that the country and the people will be led by god and create Christian culture. This is not something unrealistic. We start with small things. In the culture where dark spirits rule over, we created cultures like Harvest Night to protect our children.

Praying a few minutes per day for this country and proclaim gospel is what is needed. God’s kingdom made it this far through people who seemed weak and least expected. Let’s pray. Let us have discernment. And Let’s make simple solution of Creating Christian culture that will replace the culture of this world and proclaim Gospel. Jesus is enough.
