Before the New Life Festival (KM Revival)

TFBC typically has 2 revivals in the spring and in the fall during a year. In the past, during 1970s to 1990s, as churches were growing, many gathered for the revivals. It was my youth days but I attended adults revival and was blessed by the revivals. I remember the passionate messages of guest speakers and heated worship places. It was always full house so if you wanted to sit, you needed to come early. There were many repentance and rededications.

In early 20th centuries in Korea, there were 3 revival movements. 1903 Wonsan Revival, 1908 Pyongyang Revival movement and 1909 One million march. Among those, Missionary Noble said in Korean Mission Field that Pyongyang revival that started in Jangdaehyun Church was the most powerful work of Holy Spirit since the days of the Book of Acts. It was spread over the peninsula for 6 months.

The revival started from the worship message for men at Pyongyang Jangdaehyun Church. It was a trend where missionaries and Korean pastors preached messages. For a week, day and night, all congregation gathered and listen to the message and prayed and praised.

One of the focus of the revival was repentance. Many heard the message and publically confessed their personal sins. They continuously sought for forgiveness and prayed. Next thing was that many repentance happened. Christians who stayed only at church went out and started to evangelize. Lastly, new changes and dedication followed and it impacted the society. As a result, churches grew healthy.

Our pastors prepare each Sunday worship like they are prepare these revivals. The revivals focus on the messages and prayers with evangelism in a short time period. Many churches lost the focus on spiritual renewal. As a result, many lost the heart for the saving the lost.

The word, revival means literally relive. Therefore revival means renewal. The hearts that are prepared by the prayers and praise are renewed by the word of God and thru Holy Spirit and experience the dry bone reliving.

KM Fall Revival has a title of New Life Festival. As we renew, we also lead the lost to God. Through prayers, we make a list of people we invite and as we meet them, we invite them to Jesus villages and Mission Union groups. On the day of revival, we invite them to teh revival and they will be able to hear the message that is prepared for them.

What pleases God the most is leading the lost to Christ. As we are the season of Harvest, let us give ourselves to God first and lead other lost soul to God and we will enjoy the true thanksgiving of harvest.
