To Loving members of TFBC, regarding bylaw process

An announcement was made to all deacons in their meeting in January and April 2016 that the church bylaws and constitution would be drafted.

- 1) TFBC has been conducting ministry based on rules from past meetings and upon the foundations of the Southern Baptist Church as well as policies that were present for deacons (ordained and appointed) and pastors.
- 2) The current TFBC bylaws are outdated and were not being utilized. Therefore it was determined that a new constitution and bylaws should be drafted and approved prior to the end of this year (2016) for this new era of TFBC's existence.
- 3) In the recent past, the Church leadership (Pastors and ordained deacons) has been building the bare bones of church bylaws utilizing biblical values.
- 4) During the July Deacon's meeting, 5 ordained deacons and 4 ordained deacons in training were asked to form a committee to rewrite the bylaws. In addition, 4 appointed deacons were elected by the body of appointed deacons in order to represent the membership at large.
- 5) This bylaw committee has spent a great deal of time over the past months constructing and discussing the new constitution and bylaws.
- 6) For the sake of being thorough, the bylaw committee consulted an advisory committee of previous elder figures and deacons of TFBC.
- 7) Today, at this deacon's meeting, we will shape and approve the new bylaws and constitution.
- 8) According to Southern Baptist tradition, the final step will be a congregational business meeting to approve the bylaws. (2/3 votes needed to approve)
- 9) After approval by the congregation, the bylaws and constitution will be forwarded the Southern Baptist Convention where it will be reviewed by the convention's attorneys prior to finished and approved document being submitted to the State of Washington.
- 10) The TFBC Constitution and Bylaws are for us as a congregation to confess our faith, to remind and affirm our convent with God, and to set establish the order of the church as a community of sanctified believers who proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to a fallen world.

No humanly constructed bylaws can be perfect. The foundation and norm for the conduct of the church is the inerrant Word of God. The number one priority in our lives as church members is to make the Word of God our biggest priority.
