Today is Thanksgiving Sunday. The origin of Thanksgiving Sunday comes from the Feast of Harvest. In Exodus, between mid May and mid June, at the time of harvest for wheat, it was to give it to God. The story comes from Korean Living Life book.

There was this sister who had thrombus that was a size of a baby's head on her neck. It was connected with blood clog so we was facing near death. She decided to attend Healing conference with desperateness. She realize that Jesus finished all on the cross. She also heard a message that was telling her that Jesus freed all from disease. The proclaim with faith that she is healed. Next year, she returned to the same conference to celebrate 1 year of her healing. However, the thrombus was still on her neck. She returned the following year and shared the same testimony with still thrombus on her neck. Some people started to think that she might be crazy and it came down to people asking her to refrain herself from sharing testimonies.

That night, the sister prayed. She asked God heal her for the sake of the people who were not able to be healed although she was certain that she was healed by the truth she heard. The next day, thrombus disappeared from her neck and she testified before the people. She testified that if you believe in Jesus, you must also believe that Jesus will take care of our weakness as well. If you surrender 100% to God, He will take care of your 100%. Often we are barely able to give 87%. We must be determined to give 100% to God. Then we will experience miracles in life.
