As the weather has been cold lately, now the rain started to come down again, I realize that I live in WA. I have two conference speaking engagement and I would like to ask you to pray for those.

The first is Europe KOSTA in Germany from Feb. 14-17. KOSTA (Korean Students All Nations) started with well known pastors in DC in 1986. There were 200 gathered for the first meeting. Now, after 30 years later, 20,000 Korean international students meet in 26 different countries each year and became one of the biggest young adults retreat/conference in church history.

As I was an international student myself, I attended KOSTA in Chicago for 10 years. As I was studying theology in English and facing many difficult financial struggles and also serving in ministries over the weekend, I often got spiritually dry. Then my wife and I would go to KOSTA and from early in the morning to 10PM and small group meets afterwards, we were blessed through KOSTA.

Three years ago, during my vacation in Korea, I took a week to speak at KOSTA in Japan and between my wife and I, we had preached 11 times. I wanted to pay back the blessings that I had received from KOSTA in the past. Over 5,000 people gathered in a large tent and in 90 degree weather, my wife and I were blessed to see many cry out of joy and blessing in Gospel.

There were a few request before for me to speak for KOSTA but I have been declining due to church ministries. This time, I would be speaking as main speaker for 4 times. The reason for this decision was that this year marks the 500th anniversary of reformation and KOSTA will be in Germany where the reformation took place by Martin Luther. 20 years ago, my tearful prayers on the concrete floor of Wheaton College and committeemen to share the blessing with others as I have is now happening.

I ask for your intercessory prayer during the Europe KOSTA as I serve the churches and pastors and young adults in different countries and I would be able to share blessing with others.

As I return on Sat, I will preach on Sunday and I will be leaving to speak at KSBC Mission Conference in LA as a guest speaker. The topic is "Church Renewal and Leadership Change" I will be speaking and counseling in those areas. Many local church pastors, their wives and seminary students will be attending the conference.

As you pray for both conferences, please pray that through the powerful prayer of TFBC, all participants will experience the power of Holy Spirit and God will use me to preach bolding the message of God's Kingdom and Jesus Christ.

I am speaking in both conference without pay. It is because there are many international student participates and small local pastors are attending and they have financial struggles. You are not able to come with me but as God convicts your heart, I hope that you can join me through prayers and financial support. (Designated Offering: Europe KOSTA/ KSBC Mission Conference)
