#### To Loving Members of TFBC

KM Revival Guest Speaker, Pastor Daniel Lee who is one of the great preacher in Korea has been blessing us with messages. He has been preaching with the theme of "Healing and Serving" through a long experience of ministries, applicable insights of word of God, intelligence, and abundance humors.

As we experienced God through the mission conference, through the KM revival, we see god's plans of restoration and calling.

After next week, we reach the highlight of LENT, Passion Week. Starting 2 years ago, we are doing 7 Days of Holy Challenge. This year, we are doing a special prayers with 7 different topics. With the 7 topics coming from the life of Jesus, let us reflect and apply to our lives.

#### 1. Holy Waste (Mark 14:1-9)

Just like the woman who broke the alabaster jar, as we practice the giving of holy things to God we give the best offering for the Resurrection Sunday and express our gratitude to Christ who died on the cross for our sins. It is not wasting our money on this world but spending for the Lord.

#### 2. Victorious Paradox (John 12:24-33)

As one wheat seed falls and dies, it produces many fruits, and as you love your life will lose your life, and as you hate your life will keep your life forever and it is understanding the paradox which leads to victory. During 7 days, it is to keep your anger, forgive, yield and experience yourself dying so that the true self will come alive. The cross is the greatest paradox.

#### 3. Serving with Love (John 13;3-15)

As we mediate on Jesus who washed the disciples' feet, let us search for one that we can serve for a week. Send a card, a text, spend time and inviting the person to the resurrection Sunday to practice loving the lost soul.

#### 4. Awakened Prayer (Matthew 26:36-46)

It is to challenge 6 days of Early Morning Prayers. Fighting against tired body and sleep, it is the time to pray awake. Without the suffering of the cross, there is no glory of the resurrection. God's special grace will be upon the awakened prayers.

#### 5. Complete Sacrifice (Mark 15:25-39)

As Jesus cried out "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me," Jesus has given all with the complete sacrifice to bring the salvation to us. Let us find one area in our lives that we are not able to fully suffering and make a decision to give that up to God. With fasting and prayers, let us make the decision.

#### 6. Devotion with actions (John 19:13-42)

Unlike Nicodemus and Joseph of Arimathea, let us move on from just loving Christ in discreet and make a decision with courage. We should not just attend a church but live with devotion and actions. We commit ourselves to the church community ministries which is the body of Christ

#### 7. Glorious Resurrection

Jesus who we follow and believe passed through the suffering of the cross and faced the glorious resurrection. As we mediate the passion week meaningfully, the glory of the resurrection Sunday will come to us differently. We will also find that it was our works but it was the grace of God that we are able to do this. it is the blessing that is given to those who obey.

Let us join for the 7 days of Holy Challenge. Let us leave all behind and equip ourselves. It is hard to do alone but we can finish if we work together. As we expect the power of the resurrection of the Lord...
