Not just Korea but the whole world is excited and paying attention to Winter Olympic in Pyeongchang, Korea. There were concerns since some of the countries were planning to not come to the Olympic.

More than anything, the biggest concern was the North Korea's nuclear and ballistic missile were completed and there was a tension. North Korea government seemed to be wearing a mask of peace and trying to make peace with others but as many are watching North Korea as it is matter of time that they would change back to the old ways.

During 2002 World Cup in Korea, I was thankfully in Korea. I was attending MK (Missionary kids) Conference. I had an opportunity to meet with missionaries from all over the world. I did not have a chance to watch the actual game at a stadium but we visited a stadium where Brazil was playing in Suwon. It was not to watch the game but to share gospel with the people who came for the game.

As Korea was in a festive mode since Korean team was doing well. So many of the people's hearts were open and many other people from different countries cheered for the Korean team. I shared gospel with a person from Africa and another from South America. As many were watching the game inside the stadium, we were sharing gospel along with missionaries and having a game of heaven.

It was undeniable fact that God was more focused on the evangelism outside the stadium than the game that was going on inside which the best team in the world, Brazil was playing.

There is Mission Celebration Conference during the week that the winter Olympic ends from Feb 21 to 25. We have 9 missionaries coming to the conference. Four people from Southeast Asia are not able to come because their Visa was rejected. There will be another chance but it is disappointing. There will be a conference on Wed and Friday at 7PM with 2 missionaries preaching and Sunday will be a joint service with my preaching. (KM will have Thursday and Friday separate service)

Our WMU will also be doing something. Their cooking is the best in the world but there is no cook who are recognized by the world. Cooking shows are popular now days. But God is watching not those who are on TV and entertaining people but watching people who are cooking and pleasing people behind the curtain.

As we eat one kimbob and a bowl of soup, the burden on the missionaries are lightened since the profit will go to support the conference. A church is a place where those who cook and those who eat are supporting with joy. What I want to ask you to do is that the biggest encouragement we can give to missionaries is to come to the conference and listen to their mission stories.

When will you be in your life to be able to hear the great testimonies from the missionaries and pray fervently for the mission. As you fill the seats, let us be the cheerleaders who cheer for the missionaries who are fight the battle for Christ. The kingdom of God is near.
