To Loving Members of TFBC

On Feb 21, we were starting our Mission Conference. On that day, the greatest evangelist in the history of Christianity went to be with the Lord. Billy Graham at the age of 99 went to be with the Lord at his house in North Carolina on 21st of February. He was born on November 7, 1918 so He lived almost 100 years, a whole century.

He was a pastor of SBC. He was an advisor and a mentor to many president starting with Eisenhower as he was called presidents' pastor.

In his ministry, he traveled to over 185 countries and shared the gospel to 200 million people. He is the preacher who preached to the most people in the history of Christianity. One critic said, there were over 2.5 million people who accepted Christ after hearing his message in the year of 1993 alone.

When Jesus was on the earth, He said, "Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father."(John 14:12) As Jesus' words of promise shows, we see how the spiritual fruits of the ministry works as we share the gospel.

Billy Graham's grandson, Will Graham said through Christian Post after his grandfather passed away, "When my grandfather was around, he said, 'You will someday hear Billy Graham has passed away but I will be more live than ever.' "

And Will Graham described his grandfather's passing as this: "The moving was just completed. Today is the day my grandfather moved from the land of death to the land of living." It is so. The death of Christian is moving from a rented house to a permanent and eternal home.

Billy Graham and Korea had a special relationship. During the Japanese occupation in Korea, his wife attended a school in Pyongyang. Billy Graham was brave enough to have a revival in Seoul and North Korea in 1952. And in 1958, with the invitation of Seungman Lee, he came for the second revival in Seoul ground. And finally, he had his crusade in 1973 in Yeouido, over 1.1 million people gather on one day and it was recorded as the biggest evangelical meeting in the 2000 years of Church history.

In 1984, for 100 anniversary of Korea mission celebration, there was another worship meeting with Billy Graham and I was there as a young student. It was under a scorching sun however clouds came to cover the sky during the service that it was cool weather until the sermon ended. It still stays in my memory.

There were theological criticism on Pastor Graham. Those areas, the history will be the judge of it and above all, God will decide. Despite some of the short comings, God has giving the privilege to Billy Graham to preach the gospel(Jesus is the only savior and Lord) to 200 million people and I praise God's greatness for that. Despite all criticism, it is undeniable that Billy Graham is the greatest evangelist that God has allowed to be in 20th century. I want to have in my heart that fiery passion to the lost soul that Billy Graham had. I want to have the boldness that he had.

I expect another work of revival to Korea, America, and all mission fields around the world that will be given in the last days. I pray that the revival and renewal will be upon the upcoming KM Revival. As Jesus is preparing the revival, let us be obedient and invite the lost souls to the revival. More than anything, we need to be in the place of blessing. As we expect the bless of 1973 again...
