To Loving Members of TFBC,

As Washington state had snow last week, everything was covered in snow. It was a snow storm we haven't' had for 40 years that there were many accidents and school and government offices were closed. Some of our members were injured from slip and fall and we need to pray for them. It was a great time to see white snow. Since Washington has many big trees, we see many covered in snow.

Today, I wanted to share about mission, milal(Wheat Mission), and KOSTA. Recently, we were blessed by the messages from Missionary Wanjoo Park of Hungary Gypsy Mission. Last year and this year combined, you have designated over \$10,000 for his mission so we have gave him the support. This summer, August 5-11, we will be going to the mission with KM, EM, Youth and YAM to do Gypsy mission (about 35 people team) Students and young adults will do VBS and adults will serve for medical mission and we will have night worship services.

After the mission, I will be serving as a guest speaker at the Eastern Europe Mission Conference in Greece as I did last year (Eastern Europe Mission: Greece, August 12 -17) There is one more mission to Turkey, visiting 7 churches/Holy Land in October. We are taking registration today and we will have mission presentation on March 17 as we did last year.

Last Wednesday at KM service, 20 Milal (Wheat Mission) state directors came from US and South America. Milal Mission started 40 years ago by Dr. Jaesu Lee and he is visually impaired. There are now over 67 ministry locations and over 10,000 special needs people are being ministered by this organization.

Our Agape class at 11AM started by Milal Mission. We will have Agape Class dedicated Worship in May. We had \$2,000 offering during last Wed special love offering. Some members were not able to attend Wednesday service due to the road condition. So as I have announced on Wednesday, I would like to give offering to Milal another \$3000 from M52 to support the ministry (total of \$5,000) We have been supporting Milal for \$2,000 each year and we also supported Pastor Chang when he came down to serve at least \$5000 per year for 4 years.

I will be speaking at KOSTA(Korean Students All nations) from Feb 25 to March 5 in Germany. KOSTA started in 1986 in Washington DC with 200 Korean students as a retreat. Now this retreat has become one of the amazing student movement in history where over 26 locations and 20,000 people come.

I will be speaking to young adults and youth 4 times at KOSTA and in the weekend, I will be preaching at the local churches in Germany. There will be 500 students and Koreans at KOSTA. If you like to support for KOSTA, please make a designated offering (KOSTA).

What I want to ask you is for you to join and pay your attention to big and small ministries in and outside TFBC. I also ask you to pray that through your prayers, many who come to the conference will experience the power of Holy Spirit and God will use me to proclaim the kingdom of God and Jesus Christ.

Also, as we are praying every morning, continue to pray for EM pastor search. Also I encourage more people to join the choir and the praise team.

I love you and thank you. I bless you in the Lord.
