To Loving Members of TFBC

The challenge of the 7 holy days has ended. Personally, it was difficult for me physically. I do not even know how we were able to do the chain fasting prayer for 40 days and 21 days of Daniel fast in the past while we were still doing daily ministry. It must have been the power of Holy Spirit that led us.

However, this year's passion week seemed different spiritually. Something was lacking yet I felt God was pouring His blessing upon us even more than before. I felt the prayers of the people were more maturing and they were desperate prayers being lifted up. Usually the number goes down as the week goes but I saw new people coming after Wednesday.

On Good Friday, more people came out than previous year. I felt like passing out but I experienced His Grace filling the place. Prayers are changing and what we are asking is also changing. It was special 7 days of challenge.

My point is that we were not well prepared and lacking in many things but God pour more of His spirit upon us than ever. Many came out for Saturday Morning service. We shared about Joseph of Arimathea who buried Jesus and Nicodemus' faith. Apostle John showed their faith as intimate and faith with actions and how they changed over time. Nicodemus sold all he had for the funeral of Jesus as it was worth 100 years worth of wage. Joseph allowed Jesus to be buried at his burial site.

These two are the ones that saw the body of Jesus closer than anyone else in the history. They are remembered as those who buried Jesus. As they watched Jesus, they became the disciples and they were no longer in the shadow secretly but came out to the light of truth.

Why did they risk everything to hold onto the body of Jesus despite the position that they had in the society and continue to act in bravery? Did they not know about Roman empire's stand on Jesus? They did and they knew it so well that they love Jesus in secret.

But why now? Why now with the dead body of Jesus? Was it out of guilt? What would be a gain for them now Jesus had died?

As Nicodemus was reflecting on the death of Jesus on the cross, he understood the meaning of what Jesus said in John 3:16.

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

They just realized that the one who died on the cross is the true son of God and the messiah that they have been waiting for. Joseph and Nicodemus never expected the resurrection of Jesus. Otherwise they would've been there on the third day to witness the resurrection. However, Jesus has risen. He has kept His promise of giving us the eternal life.

We are blessed people. Through the Bible we understands those events and we are able to celebrate the resurrection Sunday. The cross that extinguish our sins and revives us is the true hope for us. Jesus has risen.
