The reason is that your new year's resolutions have hit the wall of reality and things are not going your way. As you negotiate with the reality and even give up on things, you get depressed and your body gets sick.

How about you? Are you a warrior who is moving forward like 8cylinder sports car and never making mistakes or never having pressed thought? Probably, there is no one like that. It might be the other way around. As you have passion for things and as you see your goal and the reality is pretty far from each other, you would get more depressed and face slump.

Probers 16:1 and 9 tells us about our life.
