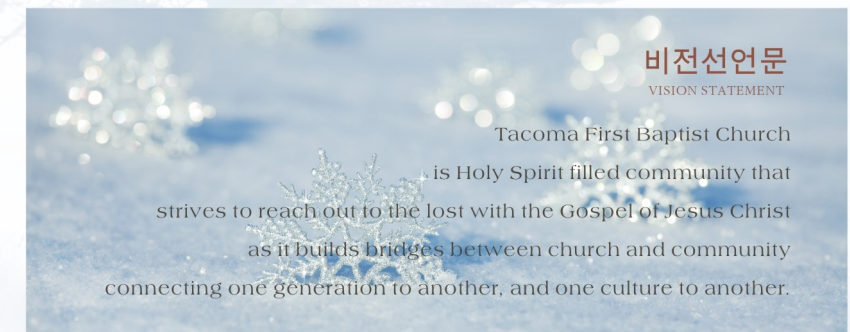

To Loving Members of TFBC

As the reformation day is around the corner,

For the history of Christian Protestant, it is important Sunday. It is the 500anniversay Sunday of Martin Luther(1483-1546) who was a catholic priest started the reformation. October 31, 1517, as the sale of indulgences and corruptions of Catholic church was at the peat, Luther posted 95 theses on the door of Wittenberg Castle Church in Germany. This trigged the reformation of 16th century.

However, Martin Luther was not the first who pull up the red flag against the Roman Catholic. 150 years earlier than Martin Luther, John Wycliffe(1320-1384) a catholic priest, translated the Latin Bible to English where only priest and catholic leaders could only read. He made impacts on William Tyndale (1494-1536) that he made English translation of the Bible. Tyndale was burned to death for translating the Bible into English.

There was another reformer who was influenced by John Wycliffe. His name is Jan Hus, Goose(1372-1414) of Czech. He petitioned about the Roman Catholic and churches' repentance of corruptions. Jan Huss, influenced by Wycliffe preached that Bible is the only authority of faith and was expelled by the Roman Catholic and was burned to death in 1415. Jan Hus was supported by the people in Bohemian region but it was not enough to go against Roman Catholic and its leaders.

As he was burned to death, his last word was “In 100 years, God will raise up a man whose calls for reform cannot be suppressed.” And as Jan Hus said, 101 years later, with Martin Luther, the reformation started.

Personal reformation or community reformation does not start in one day. In Old Testament time, after Southern Kingdom of Judah fell, the wall was not restored for 140 years however, Nehemiah restored it in 52 days. But if you look at the history carefully, God planned for the timing and let it happen on Nehemiah's time.

Before Nehemiah were Zerubbabel and Ezra who led the revival and there were many other prophets to cried out for reformation and repentance and prepared the way.

Your sacrifice and tear might not lead right away to the fruits but as we continue to plant seeds with our best as God's word teaches, In His time, His work will be revealed and we will be able to witness it.

As it took a long process of the corruption of the church, it took a long time for the reformation to take place with sacrifices and tears of many. God made sure that those did not go in waste. What's more important than us being Martin Luther or Nehemiah is that we do are best to be faithful to the smallest thing as we obey His command

500 years later, we live in the era that needs another reformation. Let's pray together. Let us cry out to God. Let us obey God's Calling for this era. We need to fix our eyes on Jesus.
