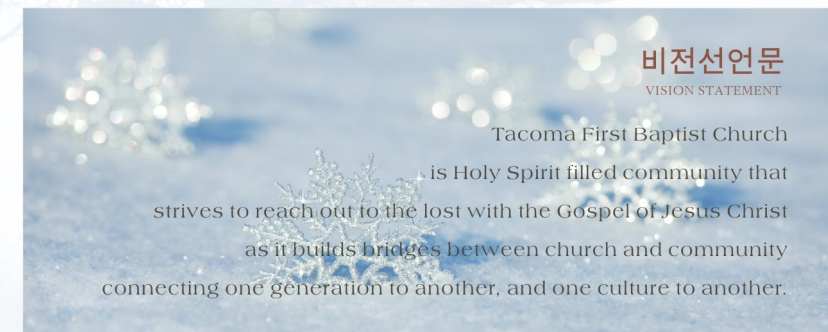

Today's is the last day of Korean Lunar New Year. I see people making rice cake soup and eating while thinking about the home country. My son bragged about Korean school making rice cake soup and playing a traditional game. He wanted to play it at home since teachers did not let him run the game. I was thankful that Korean school gave children opportunity to learn different cultures while growing up in US.

When new year comes, after the special new year early services, pastors are busy planning for the year and also do business visitation. I tell the pastors that December and January are the deadly month. Then we get refreshed through passion week and then resurrection on the resurrection Sunday. ^^

Including new comers, there are 60 business run by church members. Because we have many military families, we have considerable a fewer personal business for our church size. Pastors and I visit about 10 different business and bless them. When I was dead tired, I was encouraged seeing people still going to early bird and then go to work and get home late.

I hear some say, "Pastors are tired too. Thank you for doing visitation and praying for us." It is a big encouragement for all the pastors.

It saddens me to see some business struggle. When someone is laid off from work, that becomes my top of the prayer list. One is waiting for 6 months to a year for the permit to open a business. As a pastor, it is hard to see. Because everyone is in different situation, pastors prayers go out for those who are hurting more, or struggling more. It is encouraging to see that people do understand that.

One thing that I have committed to do is to bless the business and economy as members are serving, giving and helping others despite their struggles. That is something any pastor should do but even from last year, the desire even grew stronger because I saw people giving and serving despite their situation in the last 6 years of visiting hospitals and business. We have 2 police offers, and at least 5 or more are deployed and there are always military trainings so I always pray for safety of the members.

This year, I pray that our families, children and business will receive big blessings from the Lord. Lastly, I think we should use our members' business for village meetings, and ministry meetings and other things.

This is what Pastor Nathan shared during the business visitation. I hope that you will meditate on Psalm 128, You will eat the fruit of your labor; blessings and prosperity will be yours. I pray that this will be fulfilled in you. I love you and thank you. I bless you in the name of the Lord.
